EXTENSION NEWS

At last we have contracts signed and work on the extension will commence before we close in June, most likely on the week of the 13th - 17th June. It has been a long hard struggle to get to this stage as we were trying to build considerably more than we had been granted funding for. Having fought with the Department we have managed to secure further funding on two separate occasions and this extra grant aid, together with our local fund raising and a contribution from the Board of Management still sees us short €42,500 so we have to scale back our project somewhat. We will be building the two new classrooms as planned and making the necessary changes to the toilet area and office. However we do not have sufficient funds to build the new staff room, so room 5 will become the staff room once the building work is complete. Therefore we will be unable to convert Rooms 2 & 3 into one room as planned as we will need one of these rooms for learning support and a classroom. This work will effectively become stage two of our building project. Hopefully over the next 2-3 years we will be able to raise sufficient funds to complete this work. For the duration of the build, Room 5 will be used for office and staff room and some Learning Support. Most of the Learning Support will be in-class support. We would ask people to be as patient and understanding as possible while the building takes place. We will have to accept some inconveniences.
