CLASSES FOR SEPTEMBER 2022

As you know our enrolment numbers are bottom heavy, meaning we have higher numbers in the junior classes as we have boys up to 2nd class. While we try our best to avoid split classes sometimes it is our only option to ensure there are equitable numbers in each classroom. Should any class be split those involved in the split, are randomly selected. This arrangement has been in place for many years and rest assured that the full curriculum will be covered in all classrooms.

This year we are projected to have 15 new entrants. We will be splitting the current junior & senior infant classes. Some current Juniors will remain in Ms. Kinane's room as a group of Senior Infants and some will be in Mrs. McMillan's room with some 1st class. Likewise some Senior Infants will remain in Mrs. McMillan's room as a group of 1st class while the remainder will be in Ms. Bailey's room together with 2nd class. Should your child remain in their current room it does not mean they are being "kept back". All teachers will be covering the same curriculum and will be liaising closely.
