
The Parents Council are holding a meeting tonight (Wed 29th Nov) @ 8pm to discuss concert preparations, your help and support would be appreciated.

After School Activity Programme (1st—4th class) is run in conjunction with Parents on Wednesdays from 3.10—4pm. The idea is that pupils are in small groups and are active for as much time as possible and are not waiting for their turn to come as can be the case in a regular P.E. class where there is one teacher to 28/29 pupils. Ideally in ASAP groups should be 6/7 pupils max.



Currently we only have one parent helping with this initiative and two teachers and approx. 30 children therefore the groups are made up of 9/10 pupils. We really would appreciate it if one more parent could help out. A.S.A.P. takes place in blocks of 5/6 weeks. We will be hoping to have another block after Christmas possibly starting 24th January.



BOOK FAIR

We had a very busy week in the run up to the Mid-Term break and on the Thursday 26th we had a book fair. It had been quite a while since we last had a book fair and we were delighted with the way parents

supported this. All of the money collected goes to Scholastic but we get a percentage of the profit with which we can buy books from the Book Fair or the Scholastics catalogue. Each teacher was able to get €200 worth of books for her class to supplement the class library or the reading material for the children.

We would like to remind you that the Student Council run a book club each Friday where children from 3rd to 6th class swap books among each other.
