It is important that your child's insurance (\in 8) is paid and if at all possible that should be paid to the school by the end of September.

Should you need to bring your child to hospital during the year to A&E for any reason whether school related or not. I will gladly sign a claim form for you so that your outpatient fee of €100 will be reimbursed to you.
