## SCHOOL SELF EVALUATION

We are currently on Year 3 of our School Self Evaluation. ### **BUSES**

We had a bit of a hiccup at the start of the school year with the school buses. Thankfully this seems to be resolved for most people. I am aware that others would like to avail of school transport but are either not on the current route or were concessionary ticket holders and didn't get a seat.

Please note it is vitally important to apply and pay as early as possible for your bus ticket, (the Bus Inspector has advised us that applications are accepted from January to April) and that the routes are changed to accommodate where the largest number of children are living. The routes are not set in stone and depend on the needs in any given year. So even if you are not currently on a bus route you could apply and the route may change if a sufficient number of pupils satisfy the criteria and are wanting school transport.
