GARDA VISIT

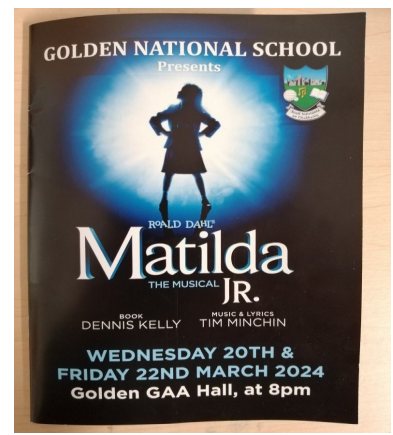
