CLASSES FOR SEPTEMBER 2019

In order to have the smallest number possible in all rooms next year and to give pupils the best possible opportunities it has been decided to have two split classes. CHILD SAFEGUARDING—How to make a report

Should a parent have a concern about a child protection issue that occurred in school it should be reported to the DLP (Designated Liaison Person) - the school Principal. Should the concern be in relation to an incident involving a school principal the report is made to the deputy DLP, the Deputy Principal. However, in the event of a parent having a Child Protection concern about an incident outside of school they make the report to the relevant club or agency. Should the concern be of a serious nature, it should be reported to the Gardai and/or Tusla. BOOK RENTAL—Fee increase

For the past three years we have managed to keep the Book Rental fee at the same rate. However as we had a substantial shortfall in funds last year we have no choice but to increase the fee this year to €55 per pupil. This still is extremely good value as it includes all books, workbooks, copies and, for infants, it also includes pencils and colouring pencils. The Book Rental agreement form needs to be completed and returned to school by 31/5/19.

The fee of €55 must be paid before 18/6/19. Should you not complete the Book Rental agreement form and pay the fee, you will have to purchase all books, copies, workbooks etc. yourself.

SCHOOL FEES—Reduction

As Mrs. Sheehan is retiring there will be no charge for drama next year. This will create a reduction in school fees from €79 to €58. School fees fall due in September 2019 and can be paid in full or two instalments of €30 & €28 each. If making an online payment please mark it with your child's name.
