1st Class

Jollyphonics 1st Class

> p. 44 Jollygrammar 1

Sound: 'y'

- Ask your child what sound 'y' makes.
- Make a list of words that have this spelling and make this sound,
 e.g. sky, fry, my, etc.
- Listen to your child reading the words in the green box on p. 44.
- Circle the words that have 'y' spelling.
- Your child must now pick words from the list of words they made and write 1 into each pan.
- For the dictation part on the 2nd half of the page, you must call out the words and sentences to your child to write. Correct after with your child.
- The dictation words and sentences: 1.my, 2.dry, 3.pry, 4.crying, 5.flying, 6.trying, 7.We try not to cry., 8.They are flying with me., 9.He was trying to sing the song.

Sound: 'ow'

- Ask your child what sound 'ow' makes.
- Make a list of words that have this spelling and make this sound,
 e.g. snow, slow, crow etc.
- Listen to your child reading the words in the purple box on p. 46.

- Circle the words that have 'ow' spelling.
- Your child must now pick words from the list they made and write 1 into each snowman.
- For the dictation part on the 2nd half of the page, you must call out the words and sentences to your child to write. Correct after with your child.
- The dictation words and sentences: 1.own, 2.low, 3.mow, 4.show, 5.grow, 6.throw, 7.It has started snowing., 8.The seeds have grown well., 9.There is a show on Monday.

Final Consonant Blend

- Call out these blends to your child and ask them what letters are in them: cl, fl, br, cr, sc, sn, tw, sk, sp.
- Not all blends are at the start of a sentence, some are at the end.
- Call out these final blends to your chid and ask them what letter sounds are in them: -ld, -mp, -st, -lt, -nd, -nt, -sp.
- On p.47, your child reads the blends at the top of the page and traces inside them.
- Your child must then finish each word with one of the final blends, draw a picture and colour.

- If you have building blocks, get your child to make a pattern using them, for example, 2 green, 2 blue, 2 green, 2 blue, etc.

Busy At Maths 2

- Ask your child if they know where the big hand goes for quarter to.
- Call out quarter to times which your child must show you on a clock.
- It is very important that the small hand is just before the number.
- The clue is in the name: quarter to 2, the small hand is going to 2.
- Complete p.117.

Time - Digital

- Write out these times and explain to your child how to show them as digital times, 11 o' clock, 2 o' clock, 5 o' clock, half past 7, half past 3, half past 12.
- Explain that the hour is always before the colon and the minutes are always after the colon.
- Complete p.118

> p.119

Time - earlier and later

- Your child will need a clock.
- Call out o'clock times and ask your child what an hour earlier and an hour later would be.
- Call out quarter past times and your child will need to show you an hour earlier and an hour later.
- Call out half past times and your child will need to show you an hour earlier and an hour later.

- It's important to tell your child that it is only the minute(small)
 hand that moves, the hour hand will not move for any of these.
- Loads of practice is needed for these because it is a difficult concept for children.
- Complete p.119.

Time - earlier and later

- Your child will need a clock.
- Call out quarter past times and your child will need to show you a half an hour earlier and a half an hour later.
- Call out quarter to times and your child will need to show you a half an hour earlier and a half an hour later.
- Both the big hand and small hand will have to move for these so they are different to the previous page.
- Loads of practice is needed for these because it is a difficult concept for children.
- Complete p.120.
