- As per DES and Inspectorate guidelines P.E. is now considered a core subject in line with SPHE and Wellbeing. We have been advised that children should be active every day. Movement breaks and structured play will take place daily, weather permitting. This will be timetabled until Halloween, at least.
- Please remember to telephone before entering the school. A sign in sheet must be completed by anyone entering the building. If you need to collect your child during school time please contact us in advance.
- School fees (€35) are due before the end of the month. This can be paid online to IBAN: IE87BOFI90593451108900 or by cash/cheque to the class teacher. Thanks to those who have paid already. Please note the school uses two IBAN's. The above IBAN is used for all payments to the school apart from the Book Rental payment.
- The school is setting up SEESAW communication link between school and home. This is the same system that was set up during Covid19 closure. Details about downloading the APP and logging into your child's account will be forwarded before the end of the month. This system will be used for homework and a direct communication method in the event of a school/class closure.
