Our "Split the Pot" winner will be announced on the Friday afternoon and a text sent to the mobile number written on the envelope with the amount they have won. The winners will also be included in our school newsletters. In the event the "Pot" is brimming, Parents Council Committee will use their discretion and may choose to draw two winners on that particular week.

Every Sunday evening you will receive a text from the school reminding you to bring in your "Split the Pot" envelopes. You might like to enter more than once as relatives or other family members might like to be included in the draw.
