5. Fr Bobby is competing in a 1km swimming race in a pool with a length of 50m. If he has completed 13 lengths, what distance has he left to swim?

6. Petrol costs €1.33 per litre. Your uncle's car can drive 14km for every litre of petrol. If he drives an average of 406km every week, how much does he spend on petrol a week?
