(Tips to help)

- Ask your child to count to 50. Use your 100 square to help if you get stuck.
- Call out numbers between 10 and 50 and ask your child to find them on the 100 square.
- Call out 2 numbers between 10 and 50. Ask your child which is smaller/bigger?
- Write down 3 numbers from 0-50 and ask your child to arrange them from smallest to biggest or biggest to smallest.
