This is a <b>big</b> elephant.	<b>Adjective</b>
This elephant is <b>bigger</b>	<b>Comparative</b>
This elephant is the <b>biggest</b>	<b>Superlative</b>

He is a happy boy.	Adjective
He is a happier boy.	Comparative
He is the happiest boy.	Superlative
